#### LETTER TO THE COMMUNITY

Dear Friends -

We are very pleased to report that in 2014, we set a new, all-time record by creating 55 community managed clean water wells in Haiti in one year! As a result, over 17,000 people in rural Haiti now have a clean water source right in their village. In addition, the trained water management committees in each community will be maintaining these wells for years to come.

We are very proud of our team in Haiti for setting this record and exceeding the goal of 50 community wells that they created at the end of 2013. Even though our revenues in 2014 were less than they were in 2013, our teams worked more efficiently to accomplish this goal. This was due in large part to a leadership training course that we conducted for our employees and others at the end of 2013 that clearly had a significant impact.

Starting in April of 2014, we began our 100 Community Well Project in the Northeast Department of Haiti. With this project, we are using a very systematic method of providing accurate data about where people live and locating all current water sources in order to better determine the best places to put the wells that would provide more complete coverage of the populations. Details of this process are described within this annual report.

We have also had an improvement in the results of our sanitation education and promotion of household latrines in 2014. The average number of latrines in rural Haiti is around 40% of the households. Our previous sanitation education has moved the communities where we have been engaged to 80% latrine coverage. In 2014 that percentage has gone up to an average of 95%, with some communities hitting 100% coverage! We intend to maintain this level and even improve it going forward.

Our work in this country for the past 17 years has only been possible with the generous support of individuals, churches, Rotary and other civic organizations, corporations, foundations and other non-profit partners. Thank you for helping us make 2014 a breakthrough year in many ways!

# 55 Community Wells in 2014 - A New Record!

We are very pleased to share that we set a new record for the number of community managed wells created in 2014. We actually exceeded our goal of 50 community wells, which was set at the beginning of the year!

As a result, over 17,000 people in rural Haiti now have clean water. Even better, their access to clean water will last far beyond 2014 as each community's local water management committee will sustain the well thanks to the Haiti Outreach training model. The Haiti Outreach staff worked extremely hard this year to become more efficient, and their efforts have proven successful. More community development animators were hired so that communities are "lined up", trained and ready for their wells to be drilled. This important element keeps our 3 rig drilling team in constant motion.

Community training can take up to 3 months or more as each group learns at their own pace. This makes it challenging to

predict when a community will be "ready" for the actual drilling to occur, which takes place near the end of the training process. So it is important for the efficiency of our drilling team that communities are "lined up" and prepared for the anticipated step of gaining a clean water well in their community.

Our staff could not have been prouder to have met and exceeded their 2014 goals for the number of community wells inaugurated. So for 2015, the Haiti Outreach team committed once again to break that record, looking to exceed 55 wells. We look forward to another banner year in 2015!

# HIGHLIGHTS OF 2014

#### **Rotarians Unite for Clean Water**

Rotary showed the power of working together when they fundraised for and executed a 15 community well project in 2014. The Buena Vista Rotary Club of Colorado partnered on this project with the Rotary Club of Cap Haitian, Haiti, and included collaboration of over 10 Rotary Clubs.

The Rotary Club of Cap Haitian selected the community of Plaine du Nord to be the area where most of these wells were to be created. While unfortunately there were a few areas with dry holes where we could not find water after drilling twice, which is not unusual, we continued to drill until we achieved 15 wells that were pumping clean water to their communities.

In addition, the Rotary Clubs of Evanston, IL and Minneapolis Uptown raised funds and adopted a well in Lagonjon, with a few Rotarians traveling to Haiti in February 2015 to help finish the well house, paint it and attend the inauguration. Also, the German Rotary Club of Aschaffenburg-Schoenbusch funded an Adopt-a-Well in Dominik, and 3 German Rotarians joined a travel team in Haiti to complete the well house and attend the inauguration on April 7, 2015.

Rotary Clubs have been incredible supporters of the sustainable development work of Haiti Outreach over the past 12 years, helping raise money for numerous community managed wells as well as the building of two public secondary schools. Participating in an Adopt-a-Well in Haiti makes an incredible life-saving difference in the lives of hundreds of people in rural Haiti!

## Sanitation Education and Latrines – Part of a Healthy Community

One of our significant accomplishments in 2014 was an increase in the percentage of households having a latrine in the communities where we have created a community managed well. In these communities, community members participate in a sanitation and hygiene education seminar.

Haiti Outreach also trains two community volunteers to continue with this education and promote every household having a latrine. As we have improved upon this training, we have also seen our average household latrine rate improve from 80% to 95% in 2014.





## Thrilled with Community Well, Proud of Her Latrine

Margaret Saintvil is a very proud woman, and rightfully so. Extremely happy that her 400 person community of Dominik in very rural Haiti was receiving a Haiti Outreach community managed well, Margaret was also eager to participate in the sanitation and hygiene training. When the Haiti Outreach animator and the community water committee emphasized the importance of every household having a latrine, she got busy and is now in the process of finishing her own latrine.

Before the new well, Margaret and her 3 children, Roselove, Clinton and Carline, had to walk 1 ½ miles(about 30 minutes) one way down a ravine to the nearest river, and then go back up carrying heavy buckets of water. All this just to get their daily water needs met, and with water they know was contaminated. Thanks to the Adopt-a-Well funding support from the German Rotary Club of Aschaffenburg-Schoenbusch, Margaret and her family no longer need to travel like that to get contaminated river water. Instead, they are celebrating that they have clean water only about 100 yards from their home!

When a Haiti Outreach travel team was there in April, we helped to clear the area around the well, hauled and sifted sand to build the concrete "house" around the well, and painted it for the inauguration that took place on April 7th. Margaret was so proud of it that she asked our team to come and see the progress on her latrine. The well inauguration was a great celebration for the whole community and our team. Margaret, along with her neighbors, thanked us all so very much for our help and support in bringing clean water to their community that they will manage and maintain for years to come.


